Subject: Consolidated Scrutinizer's Report on remote e-voting pursuant to the provisions of Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 (Act) read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 and amendments thereto and in accordance with Regulation 44 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 for the 24th—Annual General Meeting of Saksoft Limited, held on 14th August 2023, Monday at 10:30 A.M (IST) through Video Conferencing ('VC') / Other Audio Visual Means ('OAVM').

We, V Suresh Associates, Practising Company Secretaries, have been appointed by the Board of Directors of Saksoft Limited (the "Company") as a Scrutinizer for the purpose of scrutinizing the remote e-voting process and ascertaining the requisite majority, on the resolutions contained in the Notice to the Shareholders dated 25th May 2023 issued in accordance with General Circular Nos. 14/2020 dated April 8, 2020, 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, 20/2020 dated May 5, 2020, 02/2021 dated January 13, 2021, and 21/2021 dated December 14, 2021 Circular No 3/2022 dated May 5, 2022 and General Circular No. 11/2022 dated December 28, 2022 issued by Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA), Government of India (hereinafter referred to as "MCA Circulars") and the SEBI vide its Circular No. SEBI /HO/CFD/CMD1/CIR/P/2020/79 dated May SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD2/CIR/P/2021/11 dated January SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD2/CIR/P/2022/62 dated May 13, 2022, SEBI/HO/CFD/PoD-2/P/CIR/2023/4 dated January 05, 2023 issued by the Securities and Exchange Board of India (referred to as 'SEBI Circulars'), Government of India, for the 24th Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the Members of the Company, held on 14th August 2023, Monday at 10:30 A.M (IST) through Video Conferencing ('VC') / Other Audio Visual Means ('OAVM'). ESH ASS

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We also appointed as Scrutinizer to scrutinize the e-voting process during the said AGM.

The notice dated 25<sup>th</sup> May 2023, as confirmed by the Company was sent in respect of the below mentioned resolutions passed at the AGM of the Company through electronic mode to the shareholders whose email addresses are registered with the Company/Depositories, in compliance with the aforesaid MCA & SEBI Circulars.

The Public Advertisement with respect to dispatch of Notices and conducting of voting through electronic means was published in an English newspaper "Business Standard & Trinity Mirror" and in a vernacular newspaper "Makkal Kural" edition on 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2023.

The Management of the Company is responsible to ensure the compliance with the requirements of the Companies Act, 2013 and the Rules relating to voting through electronic means on the resolutions contained in the Notice of 24<sup>th</sup> Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the Members of the Company. Our responsibility as a Scrutinizer for the e-voting process is restricted to presenting a Scrutinizer's Report on the votes cast "in favour" or "against" or "abstained", in respect of the resolutions stated below, based on the reports generated from the e-voting system provided by Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL), the authorized agency to provide e-voting facilities, engaged by the Company.

The remote e-voting system remained open from Thursday, August 10, 2023 (9.00 a.m. IST) to Sunday, August 13, 2023 (5.00 p.m. IST) (both days inclusive).

The votes cast under remote e-voting facility were thereafter unblocked in presence of two witnesses who were not in employment of the Company.

The Corporate Members who had participated in the remote e voting had provided scanned copy of the resolution passed at their Board of Directors Meeting for authorization to exercise their votes through e-voting.

The Company had also provided remote e-voting facility to the shareholders present at the AGM through VC / OAVM and who had not cast their vote earlier.

The Members of the Company as on the "cut-off" date i.e. on Monday, August 07, 2023 was entitled to vote on the resolutions (items no. 1 to 3 as set out in the notice of the 24<sup>th</sup> AGM of the Company.)

After the closure of remote e-voting at the AGM, the report on voting done at the AGM and the votes cast under remote e-voting facility prior to the AGM were unblocked and were counted.

Thereafter, the consolidated results containing, inter alia, list of Equity Shareholders, who voted "for", "against" or "abstained", in respect of the each of the resolutions that were put to vote, were generated from the e-voting website of Central Depository Services (India) Limited ('CDSL') (i.e.) <a href="https://www.evotingindia.com">https://www.evotingindia.com</a> and remote e-voting at the AGM, was prepared.
